#### COURSE DESCRIPTION

James Joyce's collection of short stories, *Dubliners*, and his semi-autobiographical first novel, *A Portrait of the Artist as a Young Man*, will serve us as an introduction to a three-quarter treatment of *Ulysses* in 2024-2025. Special attention will be paid in class to those features of Joyce's prose style and narrative interest that so characterize the experience of reading *Ulysses*.
