COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will provide an introduction to the medieval Jewish philosopher Rabbi Moses ben Maimun (Maimonides) and his major philosophical work, *The Guide of the Perplexed*. Through close reading of select passages from the *Guide* and related texts, students will become familiar with the major themes of medieval Aristotelian philosophy and the particular form it took within the context of Judaism. Major themes include the relationship between reason and revelation, biblical hermeneutics, the nature of prophecy and providence, the reasons for the commandments, and, ultimately, the proper relationship between human beings and God.
